Iglulingmiut population in 1949: 283 (Damas 1963:28). This number pertains only to the region and people that Mathiassen (1928) described as "Iglulingmiut", and whose population in 1922 was 146 (see Iglulik 1921-22 data file). The 1949 census did not include residents of northern Baffin Island or any of the region south of Cape Brown.

Society codes: EA = Na22; OWC = ND5

File type: synchronic. The Iglulik 1949 data are the second of three sets that constitute a long interval diachronic sequence. The other two are Iglulik 1921-22 and Iglulik 1961.

Basis of genealogical diagrams: 10. ResGrp1 (1-11) Villages, June 1949. Note that squares (□) in the genealogical diagrams denote people (almost always small children)

of unknown sex, while a dark symbol without an "X" denotes a living person who resides outside these villages but serves as a genealogical link between villages.
